# Migration Health Assessment Centre (MHAC)



All UK visa applicants (including children and infants) will need to obtain an IOM Medical Certificate confirming that they are free from Pulmonary Tuberculosis (TB) if they are applying for a visa for the UK, for a period longer than six months.

## Instructions

- \* Search or type TB testing in Zimbabwe.
- \* Follow the link to IOM website.
- \* Press the register now button, Fill in your details
- \* Enter verification code as capital letters without putting spaces.
- \* Select an appointment date and time, Save!
- \* This should give you a reference ID which will be your username and a password.
- \* Please note we will not be able to recover your username or password.

To complete booking for **children below 11**, email passport details to [HarareMHAC@iom.int](mailto:HarareMHAC@iom.int), or make a call or walk in booking

**Booking for children is only complete after confirming with IOM.**

**To reschedule or rebook your appointment please call, email or visit IOM. NB: rebooking can't be done online.**

When you have secured an appointment for your TB screening process, proceed to make your payment.

## Payment

Payment must be made at **least two days** prior to the booked date, in USD, at any **Stanbic Bank Bank Branch** in Zimbabwe.

Transfers may take up to 7 days to reflect on our account and will not proceed with the test if they don't reflect on our account before the appointment date.

**Payment should be made in the name of the UK visa applicant**, indicating the full name and passport number of the visa applicant in the "Payment Details" box if using the regular **Stanbic Bank cash deposit form**, or in the "Mandatory Information" section if using the **IOM UK VISA deposit slip**.

Please make sure you obtain a machine-printed copy of the deposit form from the bank upon making the payment and bring it on your appointment day. Please note that bank transfers will need to reflect in our account first, before the appointment day.



## Documents

### What to bring to your appointment:

Please bring the following on the day of your appointment.

- 2 Passport size photos
- A4 size envelope for the certificate.
- Original Passport and Copy of Passport
- UK Address
- UK Phone Number
- Proof of Payment

## Procedure

- TB screening will be conducted from Monday to Friday except on public holidays and UN-recognized international holidays.
- All visa applicants **MUST** present themselves to the clinic for assessment with the required identification document
- Your appointment will be rebooked, if you do not have the required identification documents
- The initial process will comprise of a counseling session and signing of consent for all.
- Applicants below 11yrs will undergo a medical examination by the physician before a certificate is issued.
- Applicants 11yrs and above will have a chest x-ray done. Applicants will then be reviewed by the doctor before issuance of a certificate.
- Additional diagnostic procedures (sputum smears and cultures) may apply in case of abnormal chest x-ray findings, results will take up to 8-10 weeks.
- If you fail to return within seven (7) days for sputum collection, you will forfeit the chance to obtain a TB clearance certificate.
- A TB clearance certificate will be issued to the applicant if the applicant is considered free of active pulmonary disease after the TB screening process. **Do not fold the certificate, laminate or temper with the hologram.**
- Advice will be given for further testing or follow-up with the applicant's own health care provider as needed if the examination results are abnormal, but the abnormality not related to TB disease.
- The TB clearance certificate expires six (6) months from the chest x-ray date for applicants who have had a chest x-ray done, or six (6) months from the physical examination date for applicants for whom a chest x-ray is not applicable/done.
- The above TB clearance certificate's validity is three (3) months for applicants with a history of contact with a pulmonary TB infected individual.
- Please note that female applicants of childbearing age may be requested to undergo a pregnancy test in case there is uncertainty as to whether they may be currently pregnant.
- Pregnant applicants may opt not to get a chest x-ray done and instead either give sputum for TB testing done on three (3) consecutive mornings or postpone the TB screening until after delivery.

**Check all your details very carefully before signing the certificate. Do not fold or laminate the certificate. You will need to take it with you in your hand luggage when travelling to the UK and present it to the Immigration Officer on arrival.**
